FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- What do I need to send with my child on the first day of school?
 - ✓ A reusable water bottle (clearly labelled with child's name)
 - ✓ A full change of clothes (shirt, pants, underwear, socks) in case of accidents (e.g. spills)
 - ✓ A pair of indoor shoes
 - ✓ A pair of outdoor shoes (running shoes) for gross motor activities
 - ✓ A bed set including: pillow, blanket, bed sheet (twin fitted sheet or small sheet)
 - ✓ For toddlers only: diapers and wipes
- What if my child is upset on the first day of school?
 - \checkmark It is natural for students to feel upset when first starting school
 - ✓ Our teachers are highly trained and well-equipped to deal with these situations
 - ✓ We provide individualized attention to our students
 - ✓ Parents can drop off their children and feel at ease
 - \checkmark If the situation warrants, we will call you; if you don't hear from us everything is OK \odot
- My child is a picky eater what if he doesn't like anything the school serves?

- What can I send to school for my child's birthday or to celebrate a special occasion?

 - ✓ Any food items brought to school must be nut-free to the safety of all students
 - \checkmark Any food sent with the child must be clearly labelled with the student's name
- Does my child have to be potty-trained?
 - ✓ Your child does not have to be potty-trained
 - ✓ Our teachers are very experienced and help students with toilet training
- What can my child bring to school?
 - ✓ We only allow children to bring a soft toy to school however other toys are not allowed as they may break or get lost
 - \checkmark Any items brought to school must be clearly labelled with the child's name or initials
